This funding will be used to

- Support improvement in student outcomes across Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 as reported in Naplan data to achieve significant progress towards National Mean Scale Scores in reading and numeracy
- Years 3 and 5 have a target of National Mean Scale Scores in Spelling
- Further improvement in National Minimum Standards achieved, matching or exceeding national averages in reading, numeracy and spelling across all 4 year levels
- Continued improvement in senior exit results, improving upon the achievement of QCS State Mean in English
- Maintenance of OP 1-10 54.7% of OP eligible students
- Continued achievement of 100% Queensland Certificate of Education for Year 12 students
- Progress towards 90% A-C Level of Achievement across Years Prep to 11

Our initiatives include

- Literacy and Pedagogical Coaches operating within the College
- Additional teacher support and intervention for students at risk of falling below NMS
- Provision of STEAM learning opportunities for students working in the Upper 2 Bands for Reading and Numeracy supported by increased staffing in these areas
- Additional staff working in EAL/D to support Reading achievement
